Terms and Conditions of Entry

Please read carefully and acknowledge the following:

- I have read and agreed to the full Terms and Conditions for the Gardiner Street Arts Collective Shop
 I understand the Shop will run from July 29th - 25 December 2022.
 I declare that the Artwork entered is my own original Artwork.
 I understand I cannot change any of the details in the Entry Form after submission.
 I understand my work needs to be within the size and price specified in the Terms and Conditions.
 I understand the Artwork must be fitted with an appropriate hanging device.
 I acknowledge if my work does not comply with these specifications, it will not be sold.

- I agree to deliver my Artwork to Gardiner Street Arts Collective on:
- **Moora:** before 20th July if you intend to be part of the opening (Thursday's 9am-4pm).
- If my Artwork is unsold after 6 months, Gardiner Street Arts Collective have the right to request artists to collect their art/wares.
- I acknowledge that at point of sale, an invoice needs to be created and emailed to coordinator@gardinerartstreetcollective.com.au (this includes 20% commission).

Terms and Conditions of Entry

Gardiner Street Arts Collective Shop

Entry Criteria

1. Artists are invited to submit one to two Artwork for inclusion in the Gardiner Street Arts Collective (GSAC) Annual Community Art Exhibition (the Exhibition).
2. A diptych or triptych will be deemed as one Artwork and the total of all pieces must adhere to the size restriction of 100cm (H) x 100cm (W) including framing.
3. Artists must clearly indicate the order of display for diptych and triptych works on the Artwork Delivery Form to assist with the installation of the Artwork.
4. Only the Artist who created the Artwork can enter the Artwork for inclusion in the Exhibition.
5. The Curator will evaluate the Artwork for inclusion in the shop in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
6. Due to the public location, Artworks must be suitable for viewing by all age groups. If the Curator decides that the Artwork is not accepted for inclusion, the Artist will be contacted to arrange for collection of the Artwork.
7. The Curator's decision on inclusion is final and is not the subject of appeal.
8. Artwork must be robust and able to be displayed for the entire shop opening period.
9. Two-dimensional Artworks and their hanging systems must be suitable for hanging on hooks and lines. No wall fixings (nails or screws) are available.
10. The Curator will evaluate the Artwork/Wares before acceptance into the Shop. GSAC reserves the right to withdraw an Artwork/Wares from the Shop and will do so where it is determined by the GSAC that the Artwork is too fragile for display.
11. The medium and size of the Artwork should be suitable for the temporary exhibition facility and must meet the following entry criteria:
 - Two-dimensional Artworks must not exceed 100cm (H) x 100cm (W) (including frame); unless discussed with the curator.
 - Three-dimensional Artworks must not exceed 100cm (H) x 100cm (W) x 100cm (D) (including base); and
 - Artworks must not exceed 10kg in weight.
12. Artworks must be delivered with dry materials and with secure hanging devices attached or will not be accepted for inclusion in the Exhibition.
13. Preferred hanging devices are D-rings (pictured) or firmly attached (stapled) hanging wire.

Deliveries and Collections

14. All Artworks can be delivered to Gardiner Street Arts Collective:
 - Moora: Thursdays between 9am and 4pm unless prior arranged. Pick-ups from Perth can be arranged.
15. The Artwork/Wares Sales Form must be attached to the Artwork/Wares, completed upon delivery or emailed – otherwise the Artwork cannot be accepted.
16. Artists are responsible for the transport and packing of their Artworks/Wares for delivery, including all associated costs, plus the transport of their unsold Artwork/Wares from the Exhibition.
17. Any Artwork/Wares not collected within the specified timeframe shall be dealt with at the discretion of GSAC.

Copyright, Insurance and Legalities

18. The Artist is responsible for satisfying any copyright requirements concerning their Artwork.
19. The Artist warrants that, to the best of their knowledge, there is no cultural, religious, legal or other reason preventing the Artwork from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
20. By entering their Artwork for inclusion in the Shop, the Artist agrees to allow the GSAC to:
 - Reproduce, publish and display the Artwork, in full or in part, for use in any non-commercial promotional materials and publications.
21. Insurance of Artworks while in transit is the Artist's responsibility.
22. Once delivered to the Venue, the Artwork will be covered for loss or damage for the duration of the Exhibition – up to the time of collection on 25th December 2022.

Artwork Sales

23. GSAC makes no guarantee concerning the sale of Artwork.
24. Artists must consider the 20% commission paid to the GSAC when pricing Artwork.
25. Artwork is not to be priced for an amount greater than \$3,000, including any GST (if registered).
26. The GSAC acts as an agent (agency sale) on the artists behalf and does not take ownership of the Artwork. GSAC will not issue invoices for sale of Artwork.
27. Artists must supply an invoice to the GSAC for sold Artwork to receive payment for their Artwork.
28. Artwork/Wares will be promoted on all GSAC social media.
